

# Pantry Cook Responsibilities

## **Job Description**

- Train all aunts and uncles
- Maintain camp pantry
  - Keep food supplies stored properly
  - Keep area clean and safe
- Keep water supplies full
- Remove trash from pantry area
- Monitor any meals being cooked in camp pantry
- Help aunts/uncles with any cooking problems
- Cook their own meals in camp pantry for themselves and any guest
- Can go on daily trek as long as there are enough people to help in the pantry for dinner prep

# Cooking Aunt and Uncle Responsibilities

Each family is assigned one cooking “aunts and/or uncles”:

- Two families share a fire pit
- Cooking Aunts/Uncles share the duties of two families but individually responsible for one family

## **Job Description**

- Learning how to cook all food items
- Gather all family supplies and shared family cooking supplies for their families
- Proper label Dutch Ovens, Kettles, and Pots
- Maintain a master list of where cooking supplies came from
- Purchase food for families
- Freeze any food items needed before trek
- Properly store all food items while on trek
- Learn how to properly use, clean, and store Dutch ovens
- Start, maintain, and properly care for fire
- Daily pick up food from camp pantry

# Day in a Life of an Aunt of Uncle

Breakfast	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Start camp fire first thing in the AM</li><li>• Take kettle to camp pantry to start water boiling in kettle for hot chocolate and dishes clean up</li><li>• Take pot to camp pantry to make oatmeal on camp chiefs</li><li>• Return to camp with cooked oatmeal and other food items</li><li>• Prepare wash basins for breakfast clean up</li><li>• Return any cooking or food items to camp pantry</li><li>• Pick up lunch items for family member to pack in their bandanas</li></ul>
Lunch	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• One aunt or uncle assigned to two families stays back to help prepare dinner for their families the other can go on the daily trek with their family if they would like.</li><li>• Lunch has been taken care of at breakfast</li></ul>
Dinner	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Starting briquettes for Dutch ovens for meal</li><li>• Prepare all parts of the meal</li><li>• Before taking cooked food to family they must start desert</li><li>• Take food to families</li><li>• Eat with families</li><li>• Return to camp pantry with kettles to start water boiling for clean up</li><li>• Pick up finished deserts</li><li>• Eat deserts with family</li><li>• Bring back all Dutch Ovens for cleaning</li><li>• One stays and cleans Dutch Ovens</li><li>• The other takes back water for family to clean dishes in camp</li></ul>
